

# E-CSG: a tool for CH community









### E-Infrastructures



- The <u>JSR 168</u> and <u>JSR 286</u> standards (also known as "portlet 1.0" and "portlet 2.0" standards) for the web interface
- The <u>OASIS Security Assertion Markup Language</u> (SAML) standard and its <u>Shibboleth</u> and <u>SimpleSAMLphp</u> implementations for authentication
- The Lightweight Direct Access Protocol and its <u>OpenLDAP</u> implementation for authorisation
- The <u>Cryptographic Token Interface Standard</u> (PKCS#11) standard and its Cryptoki implementation for Grid transactions
- The <u>Open Grid Forum</u> (OGF) <u>Simple API for Grid Applications</u> (SAGA) standard and its <u>JSAGA</u> implementation for middleware interface
