Which one is suitable for me?

- Mapping to stakeholders, as an example
 - Central DCH institutions (national archives, libraries, museums) → laaS
 - Smaller DCH institutions → PaaS
 - Other institutions with DP needs → SaaS

Additional interoperability?

- Interoperability between service providers
 - Can I use the (micro)services from multiple service providers?
 - Can I use the platform of a provider and the storage solution of another?
- Migrating the archive
 - Is it possible to change providers with no or reasonable added cost (laaS, PaaS)

→ sustainability risks minimised, CH institutions more willing to use cloud-based offerings



Archival issues

- Archives as a part of e-government
 - ... and government clouds
 - Interoperability with data providers (records management systems, government databases)
 - Interoperability Solutions for European Public Administrations (http://ec.europa.eu/isa/)
 - e-SENS (e-gov service federation on European level, incl. cross-border authentication: www.esens.eu)
- E-ARK (<u>www.eark-project.eu</u>) as a project to deliver interoperability components
 - 2016 as the medium term objective in DCH-RP, 01.2017 as the end of E-ARK
